



AEA Funding Programs

AEA provides energy programs for community governments/organizations that want to investigate or implement energy conservation, energy efficiency and renewable energy options. Basic advice under these programs is free. The cost of more in-depth work such as site audits, retrofits or implementation projects is shared between AEA and the community government, and is often based on a 50/50 partnership agreement.

Community Government Building Energy Retrofit Program

- Energy conservation and efficiency for community government-owned assets
- AEA provides: energy audits, rebates, project coordination for implementation of recommendations in the audit
- Existing program, may be slightly revised next fiscal year

Community Renewable Energy Program

- Renewable energy for community government and non-profit-owned assets
- AEA provides: rebates
- Existing program, may be slightly revised next fiscal year

Community Wood Stove Program

- Wood stoves get installed in people's homes
- AEA provides: 50% funding for wood stoves/installation, project coordination
- Existing program, may be slightly revised next fiscal year

Biomass boiler and district heating system support

- AEA provides: advice and analytical work for community governments investigating installing wood pellet boilers and district heating systems
- Existing program, may be slightly revised next fiscal year













Community Energy Planning and Implementation Program

- New program based on pilot project run from 2016-18
- Details still to be determined

Low-Income Energy Assistance Program

- New program to implement energy-savings measures in homes
- Details still to be determined, likely to be rolled out next fiscal year
